3. Purpose of the processing of personal data and the legal basis for the processing

The FIN-FSA's photograph and video register is an electronic register. In connection with the metadata of the photographs and videos, the names of persons are mentioned in the case of some persons.

The photographs and videos may be published in the FIN-FSA's online services and in social media channels used by the FIN-FSA.

The legal basis for the processing is the consent granted by the data subject for the processing of personal data.

4. Categories of data subjects and categories of personal data

Categories of data subjects:

- Employees and external visitors of the FIN-FSA and the Bank of Finland

Categories of personal data:

- Photographs or videos from which persons are recognisable
- The names of some persons pictured in photographs or videos may be written in the metadata of photographs or videos

5. Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

The FIN-FSA's photographs or videos intended for internal use are not disclosed outside of the organisation nor are they uploaded to external online services or social media channels.

The FIN-FSA's photographs or images intended for public use may be disclosed to e.g. the press or for non-commercial publication purposes. The photographs and videos may be published in the FIN-FSA's online services and in the FIN-FSA's social media channels.

6. Notification of possible transfer of personal data to a third country or an international organisation

Images published in the FIN-FSA's online services and in the FIN-FSA's social media channels are publicly available.

7. Period for which the personal data will be stored or the criteria used to determine that period

The photographs and videos are stored in the FIN-FSA's register permanently.

8. General description of technical and organisational security measures

In order to protect personal data against unauthorised access, disclosure, destruction or other unlawful processing, appropriate technical and organisational security measures are used, taking potential risks into consideration. Such measures include the use of secure equipment premises as well as restriction of access rights.

9. Rights of data subjects

The data subjects in the personal data file system have the right:

- to request from the controller access to personal data concerning them and the right to request the restriction or erasure of such data or to restrict processing or object to processing.
- to withdraw consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
- to lodge a complaint about the processing of personal data with a supervisory authority.

10. Statutory or contractual requirement to provide data and consequences of failure to provide such data

Subjects are notified about photography in connection with events. When persons participate in an event, they consent to the possibility of being photographed. If, at an event, it is possible arrange seating that is not visible in photographs or videos, an effort is made to arrange this. If this is not possible, a person might be photographed.
